The unique CINEMATRAIN will set off on its journey in the middle of May

The 53rd International Festival for Children and Youth ZLÍN FILM FESTIVAL will be launched on 27th May and will last until 1st June. However, as part of the supporting programme, the popular **CINEMATRAIN** will set its wheels in motion on **15th May at 10am from Mladá Boleslav train station**. This event is paramount not only since it is the 10th jubilee anniversary of the trail of CINAMATRAIN with mobile cinema projection room but also because of all the stops it will make on its journey. Between 15-30th May it will cover a distance of around 400km from Central Bohemia through Vysočina onwards to South Moravia and its "pilgrimage" will traditionally finish in Otrokovice and Zlín. In total, **twelve towns** will offer **free entry** to projections of **films and fairytales for children and youth**. Nurseries and schools will be prioritised for the morning projections but the public can freely enjoy the afternoon viewings.



Cinematrain is a collaboration project of ZLÍN FILM FESTIVAL a České drahy which was established in 2004. Its main goal is to bring quality films and fairytales to all those who cannot visit Zlín Festival. During the nine previous years it had travelled though all the Czech regions and had become a welcomed and impatiently anticipated attraction.
