THE 56TH ZLÍN FILM FESTIVAL ANNOUNCES THIS YEAR'S WINNERS

Zlín – The 56th Zlín Film Festival is over. Members of juries have seen 148 competing films and have decided about this year's winners. The wish of the organizers that the town becomes alive with the festival atmosphere has come true. The festival was also again lucky with the weather.

This year's Zlín Film Festival has almost come to an end. The International Film Festival for Children and Youth was attended by 125,000 visitors and 53 film delegations. The screenings were attended by 41,000 viewers. The supporting event with the highest number of visitors was the concert of the band Slza. Two of this year's new features, the French Alley and open-air dancing were a welcome refreshment of this year's supporting programme.

"We had a lot of films about sports or films featuring main children characters with very busy parent who don't have much time for them," says Markéta Pášmová, the artistic director of the festival, and continues: "Another characteristic feature of this year's film programme was also a large number of directorial debuts, especially in the children's film section."

The most successful film of this year's 56th Zlín Film Festival was the Israeli film Abulele, taking a total of three festival awards - the Audience Award, the Children's Jury Award and the Ecumenical Jury Award.

This year's Zlín Film Festival was devoted to the 80th anniversary of the founding of the Zlín film studios and to French cinema. "The upcoming 57th Zlín Film Festival should be devoted to the cinematographies of the countries of the former Austro-Hungarian empire, namely Hungary and Austria, as well as Switzerland, which was a neighbouring country then," said Čestmír Vančura, the festival president. The 57th Zlín Film Festival will be held between May 26 and June 2, 2017.

FILM CLAPPERBOARDS

Auctions of film clapperboards created by prominent artists have long ago become one of the traditional events of the festival. A total of 2,174 clapperboards have been auctioned so far and 228 student audiovisual works of art have been supported from the proceeds. The tradition continued also during the 56th Zlín Film Festival. This year, the festival introduced works by 137 artists. For the first time, an electronic auction took place during which a clapperboard by Jan Saudek was auctioned. A clapperboard by Adolf Born, who died shortly before the beginning of the festival, was removed from the auction and the foundation fund will decide about its fate together with Mrs Bornová.

Clapperboards were exhibited between March 14 and May 28 in several locations in the Czech Republic. The public auction took place on Sunday, May 29, 2016 at 1 p.m. in the Great Hall of the Zlín Congress Centre. The proceeds from the auction reached a total of CZK 2,153,101, which represents a 25 % rise when compared with 2015.

For the 56th Zlín Film Festival, the FILMTALENT ZLÍN foundation fund has announced the second edition of a competition for financial support of visual and audiovisual works. A total of 33 students and emerging artists from the Czech Republic and Slovakia participated in the competition. A total of 12 projects reached the final round of the competition. Each participating team had 10 minutes to present their project to an expert jury. Ten were selected and received a total sum of sum of CZK 735,000.

Among the most interesting supported projects are the animated film Episode 11 by Viktor Svoboda, student of Tomas Bata University in Zlín, Dužan Duong's docu-fiction Bo-Hai about Vietnamese children born in the Czech Republic. The managing board also put aside a sum of CZK 250,000 as a reserve for an additional support of projects of exceptional quality. Part of the money will be in line with the fund statutes spent on the organization of the project, printed materials, exhibitions, etc. The money that will not be spent will be transferred into the next accounting period. The newly introduced way of providing financial support to filmmakers from the Czech Republic and Slovakia will continue in the future years.
